Divisions and Assignments

Patrol Division

- A. 18 patrol officers divided into three crews
- B. Shifts-three shifts available: days, swings and graveyard shift-8 hour shifts
 - *Shift rotation is every four months-corresponding with school
 - *Officers stay on same crew for one year.
 - *Sergeants and corporals make up shift command on each shift.

Investigations Division

- A. Eight detectives assigned to various specialized assignments.
 - *Property crimes, sex offenses, robberies and frauds
 - *Two school resource officers and a D.A.R.E. officer
 - *One detective assigned to metro narcotics
- B. A Sergeant and Corporal make up command for division.
- C. Evidence Technician

Traffic Division

- A. Three officers assigned for three shifts.
 - *Under the command of patrol lieutenant.

Administration

- A. Chief of Police
- B. Assistant Chief
- C. Patrol Lieutenant
- D. Executive Secretary

Records Division

- A. 2 Records Technicians
- B. 1 Special Functions

What Should I Expect?

Candidates who are accepted after the application process, which includes a typing test of 30 wpm. will be notified by Human Resources of the next step to being hired as a full time police officer or special functions officer. The testing process is as follows:

1. Complete Written Testing
2. Oral Interview
3. Background Investigation
4. Polygraph
5. Psychological Test
6. Medical/physical
7. Drug Test

Note: No mandatory Physical fitness test

If hired, you will be subjected to a minimum of nine weeks for a field training program. Lateral transfers can be shorter dependant upon your experience. You will start as a Police Officer I, which is an entry level position, straight out of the police academy, at \$16.71/hour-if no prior experience. After a six-month probation period, your starting wage will increase 3%.

If you are starting with police experience from another department, your hourly wage will be determined by the human resources department. Years of experience and/or college education from an accredited institution will also be considered.
